- Must have at least a 3.2 grade point average on an unadjusted 4.0 scale.
- Demonstrates excellence in all areas they choose to engage; academics, work, volunteering, athletics, community, civic, and faith based organizations, etc.
- ACT/SAT scores must be submitted with scholarship application and will be taken into consideration when considering potential scholarship awards.

- Applicants must meet all criteria to be considered for this scholarship.
- Completed applications must be received at the Roller Skating Foundation by February 28, 2019.
- Application must be submitted the year in which you plan to attend college.
- Award will be announced in early April 2019. Winner will be posted on www.rollerskating.com/scholarships.
- Applications with missing or incomplete information will not be considered.

7. Must include complete high school transcripts.
8. Must include a 500- to 700-word personal essay explaining how roller skating has influenced your life, your goals for the future, and how this scholarship would help you achieve those goals.
