SEVEN SCHOLARSHIPS TOTALING \$12,000 AVAILABLE TO HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS OR ROLLER SKATING ATHLETES AGE 16 OR OLDER

RSA Member Scholarships

Three scholarships in the amounts of \$3000, \$2000 and \$1000 awarded to high school seniors who are family members of Roller Skating Association member rink owners/operators, employees or family members of employees. Applicable for any college, university or trade school.

RSM Member Scholarship

One scholarship in the amount of \$3000 awarded to a high school senior who is a family member of an RSM member owner of the Roller Skating Association, employees or family members of employees. Applicable for any college, university or trade school.

Roller Skating Athlete Scholarships

Three scholarships in the amount of \$1000 each awarded to a roller skating athlete in the disciplines of artistic, speed or hockey. Must be 16 years of age or older and a card carrying member of USRSS, IHA or USARS.

RSA Scholarship Application

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

A \$3000 first place academic scholarship, a \$2000 second place academic scholarship and a \$1000 third place academic scholarship will be awarded to high school seniors who:

- Can be certified to be a family member of an owner of an RSA skating center or an employee or family member of an employee of an RSA skating center.
- Completes and timely submits the scholarship application form in its entirety.
- Must have at least a 3.2 grade point average on an unadjusted 4.0 scale.
- ACT/SAT scores must be submitted with scholarship application and will be taken into consideration when considering potential scholarship awards.
- Demonstrates excellence in all areas they choose to engage; academics, work, volunteering, athletics, community, civic, and faith-based organizations, etc.
- Must have three (3) letters of reference, one from each of the following: RSA member/affiliate member; guidance counselor; teacher.

- 7. Must include complete high school transcripts.
- Must include a 500- to 700-word personal essay explaining how roller skating has influenced your life, your goals for the future, and how this scholarship would help you achieve those goals.

OTHER INFORMATION

- Application should be submitted for the fall semester to any college, university or trade school.
- Applicants must meet the criteria to be considered for this scholarship.
- 3. Completed applications must be received at the Roller Skating Foundation by February 28, 2020.
- 4. Application must be submitted the year in which you plan to attend college.
- Award will be announced in early April 2020. Winner will be posted on www.rollerskating.com.
